In this charming play, Izzy's grandmother (her Bubbie) engages the services of a marriage broker (a yenta) for her still single granddaughter. So who do they fix her up with? Sam the pickleman.

All the members of the cast as well as the director are quite aware of our faith. Last month we wrote to you about the woman who has asked us sincere questions but was concerned about how her husband might react if she came to believe. Guess whose directing this play? Her husband – and the other day while driving Mimi home he asked a few sincere questions himself!

Also, there has been some interesting conversation with the gentleman playing Sam the pickleman. At rehearsal one day he mentioned to Mimi that the Board members of the condo had a way of making laws they didn't ever intend to have to keep themselves. "That's like a group who are written about in the Bible," Mimi told him, "the Pharisees." "Oh, do you have a Bible study in your home?" he asked. When he was told that we did, studying both the Jewish Bible and the "Newer" Testament, as we are Jewish and believe in Jesus, he remarked, "Well, He was Jewish, too, wasn't He?" The conversation was interrupted as rehearsal got underway, but a short time later he said to Mimi, "What was His Hebrew name again?" When Mimi told him it was Y'shua, he nodded and said, "That's right, I remember." We are looking forward to talking more with Sam about Y'shua.
